Epidemiological Overview

Background:

- On 5th August 2023, Nsumbu Rural RHC notified Nsama DHO of having an increasing number of diarrhea cases with suspected cases of Cholera at the facility.
- First case in this outbreak was confirmed on 10 August 2023
- Cumulative cases to date **176** including
- Affected: Chibanga, Kapisha, Chibwensolo & Nsumbu health facility Catchments
- 1 new cases in the last 24 hours
- Case fatality rate stands at 2.9%,
- National Cumulative Cases in 2023:933 cases, 19 deaths, CFR 2.0% Nationally for 2023




Figure 1: shows the distribution of Cases by date of onset of symptoms for Nsama district 5^{th} August to 9^{th} October, 2023. N=176

Public Health Actions

- L. Enhanced WASH interventions with a 100% distribution of domestic Chlorine for water Treatment at households' level in affected Areas.
- P. Heightened surveillance throughout the district and neighboring especially the high-risk communities and districts (Monitoring of Acute watery diarrhea diseases)
- 3. Enhanced stakeholder engagement and risk communication

Operational Response Gaps

- 1. Defective Porta lab and no laboratory supplies, and reagents for water quality monitoring
- 2. Shortage of transport for response activities (vehicles, boats, and motorbikes),
- 3. Inadequate resources allowances for staffs, and Community Based Volunteers.

Recommendations

- 1. Mobilize more resources to assist districts and provinces with operational costs, especially for community-based interventions.
- Mobilize transport from key line ministries and partners through District and Provincial Epidemic Preparedness Prevention Control and Management Committees




Figure 2: Shows the distribution of Cases by age and sex for Nsama district 5th August to 9th October, 2023. (N=176)
